Even if you are not attending this year, come and have fun in review of the Routings' challenges.


We'll weave in the importance of the stabilized approach and how the go around is a "no shame" smart decision sometimes.

SATURDAY FLYOUT THE CHICKEN RUN




Yeah, it'll be hot, but we're tough Let's go to Tyler County/Woodville Saturday, July 10th, 2021




SELF-SERVE SITE PROGRESS
