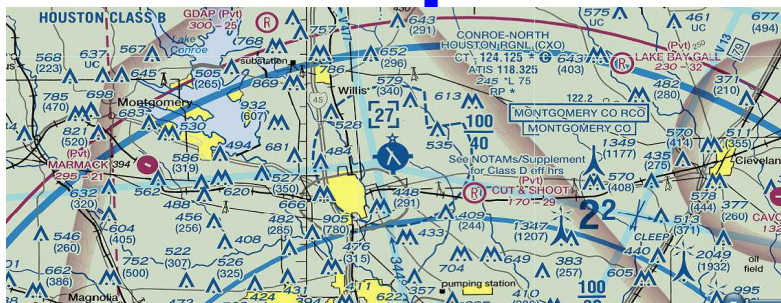

# AUGUST 14TH, 2021 MEETING MINUTES

**Call to Order:** President Joe Waltz welcomed approximately 50 members at 10 AM in the Galaxy FBO meeting room.

**Pledge of Allegiance:** Joe led the pledge.

**Treasurer's Report:** Beginning balance July 1, 2021: \$10,228.49 + \$200 cash on hand. Ending balance July 31: \$10,386.17 - \$200 cash on hand. Highlights include: Membership Dues income \$75 with Young Eagles expense \$87.95 and rent expense \$50.

**AirVenture Recap:** EAA estimated 608,000 attended AirVenture 2021. FAA reported 16,378 aircraft operations in ten days, a rate of about 116 ops per hour. Over 10,000 aircraft were supported by 5,000 loyal EAA volunteers. Members discussed their volunteer and show experiences. Congrats: Robert Skinner was awarded the Kit-Outstanding Workmanship plaque for his RV-10. Rich Jankowski won second place in the AirVenture Cup Race flying his RV-10.

**Program Items:** Watched the following videos:

FAASTeam (FAA Safety Team) program manager Phil Dixon discussed angle of attack awareness and available technology that can help general aviation pilots avoid an inadvertent loss of control. Search YouTube: *Angle of Attack Awareness in 57 Seconds*

On April 20, 2019, EAA's B-25, Berlin Express, made its first flight in decades after a thorough restoration that took nearly four and a half years. The airplane, best known for its role in the 1970 movie Catch-22, will join EAA's B-17, Aluminum Overcast, on tour throughout the country as part of our living history outreach program. **Project Updates:** Michael Woods / Hatz Bantam = Working wing tips. Covering soon. Just received Verner Scarlett 7-cylinder engine from the Czech Republic.

Mark Haskel / Zenith 601HD = Engine flywheel installed, working landing gear.

Jose Ruiz / RV12 = Porter High School build. Work starting soon. Rotax engine has arrived. Goal for first flight is in the school year.

Jim Morrical / Carbon Cub EX = Installing vinyl stripes and logos. Landing gear/flaps/ailerons painted. On main landing gear, tail wheel with brakes installed.

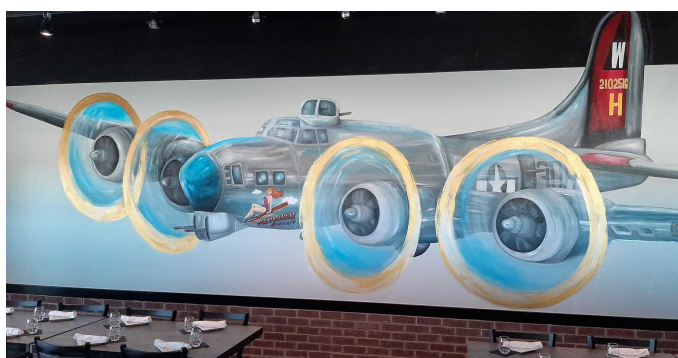
# THIS WEEK'S FLYOUT—GATE 12 CLL



What-a-Burger!!

Fly in, and park at Astin Aviation FBO on the east side. Entry from the airfield is through Astin FBO's lobby, and it's just a short walk to the restaurant. There are tables with an airfield view, more tables inside, and a small patio outside under a sun shade. Gate 12 is associated with a steak house downtown, and has an upscale menu and prices.

Be sure to save your receipt as you leave. You'll return through Astin's lobby again. They have a \$10 ramp fee which they will waive with a receipt. 100LL fuel is 5.90/gal, but you can get a \$10 reduction if you fuel for 10 or more gallons.

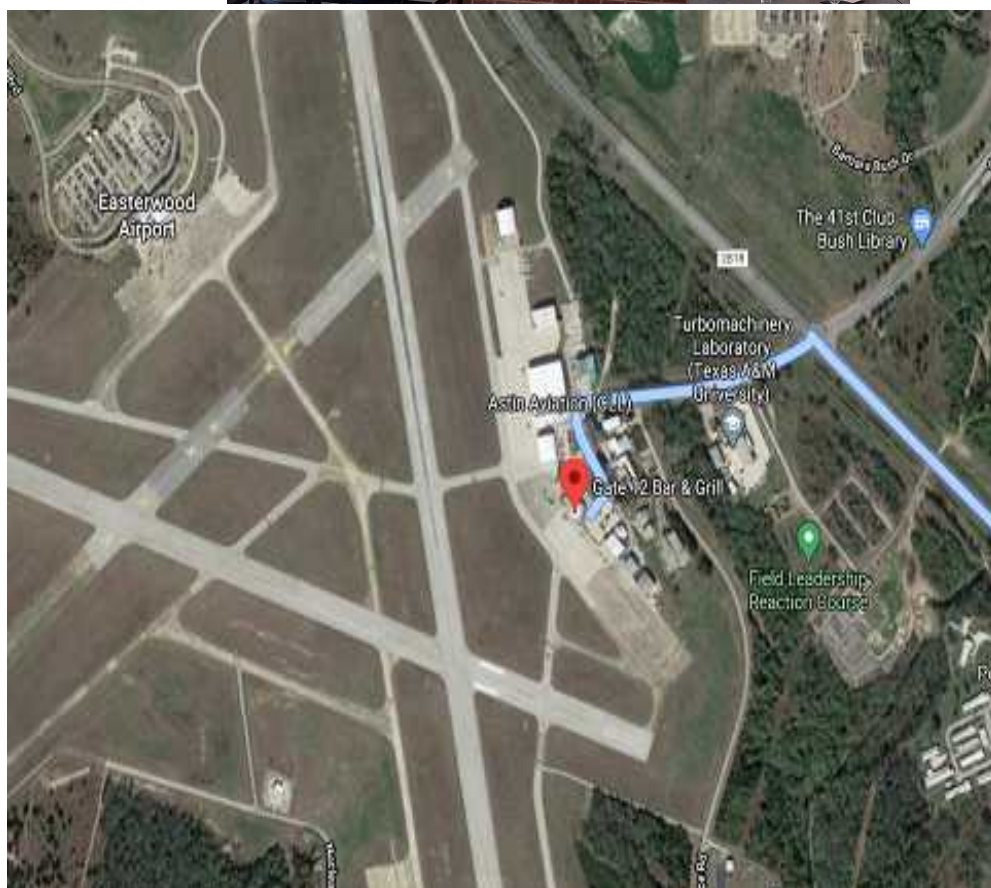

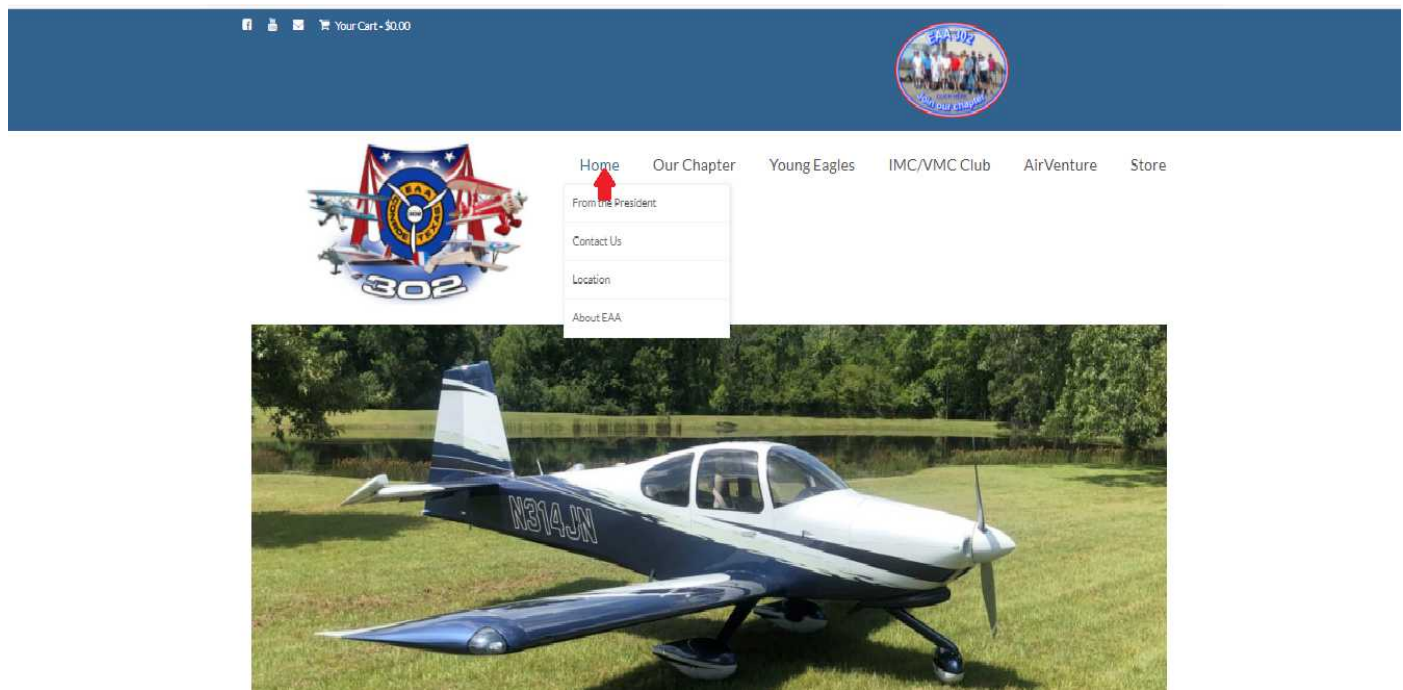

## SAME ADDRESS: EAA302.ORG

There are 6 Main Menu items on the front page. Hover on “**Home**” and you get a drop down menu of President's Welcome, Contact, Location and “About EAA”.

**Contact**—all personal data is being removed from public view on the site and the newsletter. Click “contact us” and a form pops up to fill out.

**Location**—linked to Google Maps. Tell it where you are for a route to the meeting.

Hover over “**Our Chapter**” and you get the **GOOD STUFF**—Members only, Flying Events, Newsletters and all the Builder's Logs.

# *Steven Jay Yeretsky*

November 6, 1937

July 24, 2021



Stephen Jay Yeretsky was born in Chicago, IL on November 6, 1937. He died on July 24, 2021, in Houston, TX after a serious stroke. Steve is survived by his wife, Lynn Yeretsky and their three children. Steve graduated from Hinsdale Township High School outside of Chicago. He received a Bachelor of Science in Chemical Engineering from MIT in 1958.

Following four years in the Navy, he worked for Standard Magnesium in Tulsa and Keiser Chemical in California until he began his Masters in Chemical Engineering at U. of Tulsa. He met his wife Lynn and they married January 16, 1964. He worked for Monsanto Chemical Co. outside Alvin, Tx for 35 years, living 6 years in England until 1981. He returned to work at the Chocolate Bayou plant until he retired on 01/01/2001.

Steve was a private pilot and was in the process of building a 4-place airplane, often helped by fellow pilots and family members. Steve loved flying, Dixieland jazz, Astros baseball, astronomy, and was a WWII Naval history enthusiast. Steve was healthy and active, building his airplane, keeping up his many interests and friendships until his stroke on July 8, from which he sadly never recovered. He will be missed beyond expression.

Doug passed away November 11, 2020, but funeral arrangements were delayed until this year. He flew as a private pilot for over 50 years. He also began to build his own airplanes and enjoyed helping others to build their own planes too. Doug was a part of the “on the hill gang” at the Conroe airport.
