

May 14th, 2022 Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: President Joe Waltz welcomed approximately 54 members at 10 AM in the Galaxy FBO meeting room.

Pledge of Allegiance: Noah Halliburton, Tom Kreiner's grandson, led the pledge.

Treasurer's Report: Beginning balance April 1, 2022: \$10,762.61 + \$200 cash on hand. Ending balance April 30, 2022: \$10,554.13 - \$200 cash on hand. Highlights include: Membership Dues Income \$200 and Swindle income \$96. Rent expense \$400.

Safety Minute: The FAASTeam (FAA Safety Team) program manager Phil Dixon suggests doing transition training ANY time you change aircraft, but especially moving from simple to complex (C172 to Bonanza, for example), complex to simple (Boeing 737 to an RV-6), "six-pack" instruments to glass cockpit (or vice versa), and production aircraft to kits and homebuilts. Study and get with an instructor familiar with your transition! Search YouTube: *57 Seconds to Safer Flying Transition Training*

AirVenture Adventure Helicopter: In 2010 Frenchman Matthieu de Quillacq flew his lightweight Kompress CH-7 kit helicopter from southern France to Oshkosh. He hoped to continue around the world, but made an emergency landing in Russian territory without permits and had to fly back home commercially. He still operates light helicopters in the French Alps! Search YouTube: *France to Oshkosh by Helicopter or his name to see beautiful videos in the French Alps!*

Project Updates: Mark Haskel / Zenith 601HD = Working a re-do of a winglet and pilot holes in lower flange of the firewall.

Report on Lycoming Engine School: Joe Waltz / The 5 day 40-hour Lycoming program is taught at the Pennsylvania College of Technology in Lycoming's hometown of Williamsport, Pennsylvania, by Mike Damiani—a former Lycoming factory representative with a passion for small airplanes. Half days in classroom and the half was in the lab with teammates disassembling and reassembling a four cylinder Lycoming O-360 engine. Alan Archer, Steve Iacoviello and Chuck McCluggage also attended.

Hints for Homebuilders: Brian Carpenter, of Rainbow Aviation, demonstrates an easy and accurate way to layout fabrication lines by creating paper templates with Solid Works. The paper template is glued to the material. Drill and bend to make a perfect project. Brian is an A&P aircraft mechanic with Inspection Authorization, and EAA Technical Counselor and Flight Advisor. 


Angelina County Airport Cafe




