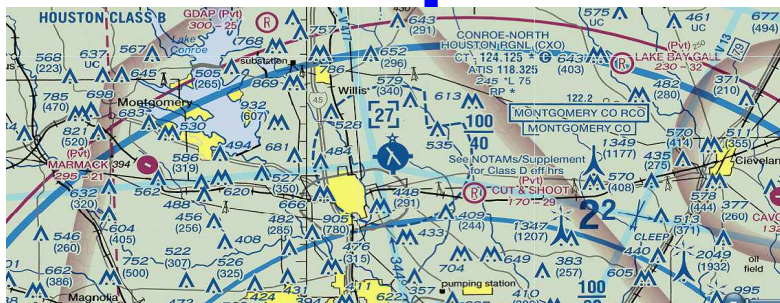

Sept 10th, 2022 Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: Vice President Miles Demster welcomed approximately 56 members at 10 AM in the Galaxy FBO meeting room.

Safety Minute X 2: The FAASTeam (FAA Safety Team) program manager Phil Dixon offers information on CBD products and how they affect your ability to fly. The THC content in CBD products is not regulated, and the amount may be unknown to pilots. Impairment and a positive drug test are both possible. Consequently, the FAA strongly discourages CBD use. In a second FAASTeam video Phil discusses manufacturer issued aircraft Service Bulletins that inform owners and operators about critical and useful information on aircraft safety, maintenance, or product improvement. 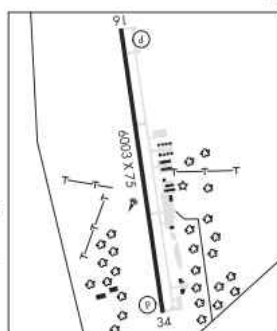


SATURDAY FLYOUT TO 11R

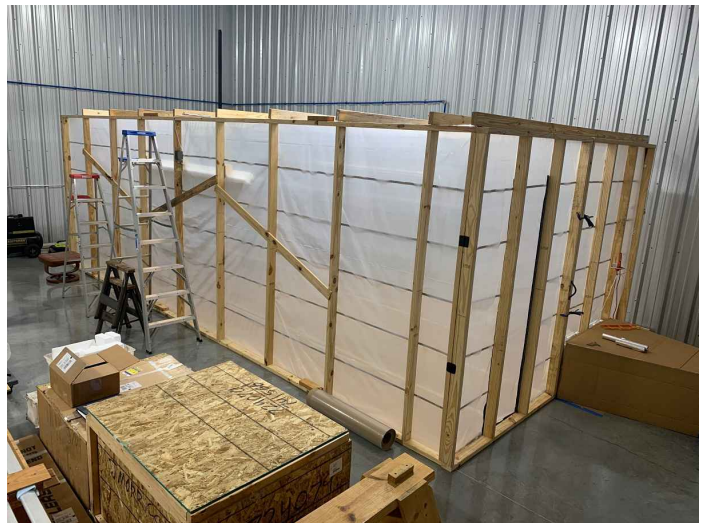
