# A Season of Sadness

## Oldest Active Pilot in USA Dies at 103.

Ralph Charles quit flying when his wife gave him the ultimatum, "It's airplanes or me." But, he resumed flying 50 years later, a year after her passing. I met Ralph at Oshkosh in 2000 when he was 100 and a forum speaker. He was living on

25 acres near Somerset, OH. Always active, he would get out on the tractor and cut the grass regularly. Had to keep the grass down so he could take off and land his Aeronca. Which I know he flew as recently as the day after his 102nd birthday!

Born in 1899, his life spanned parts of 3 centuries, and longer than the entire history of powered flight!

By 19 he was working as a welder at a shop owned by the Wright brothers in Dayton. He has built at least 7 planes, flown Stinson and Ford Tri-Motors for TWA and Atlantic Caribbean (In those days a night landing meant first dropping a flare over the field for light.), was a W.W.II test pilot for Curtis-Wright, hosted many fly-ins at his farm. *Paul*
