Again, a great big **T(H)ANKS**. *Dick Parkans, Pres.302*



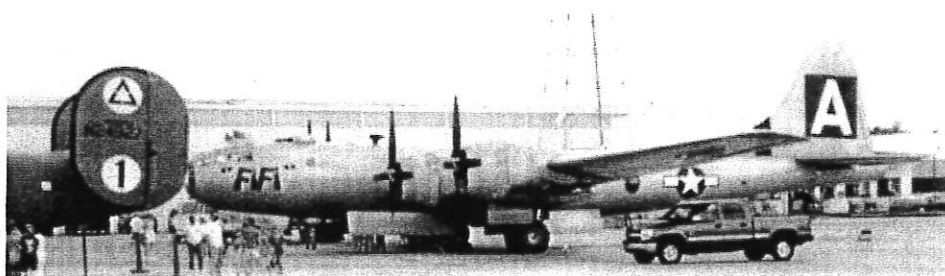

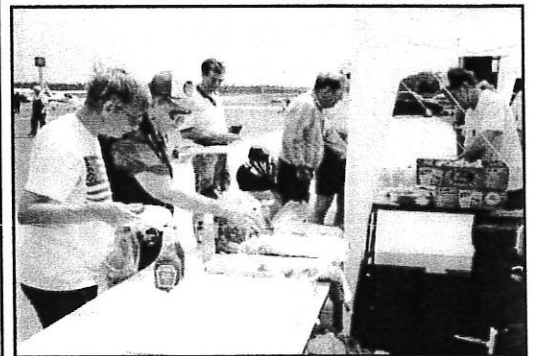
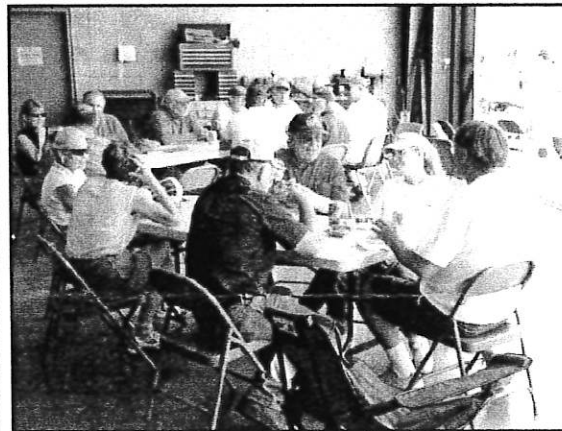
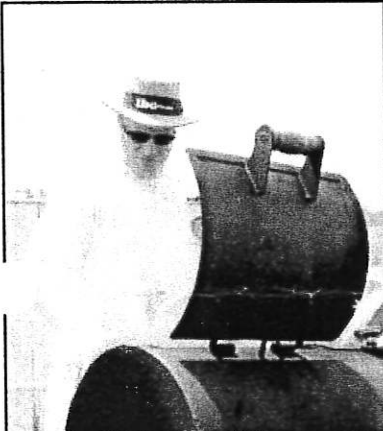
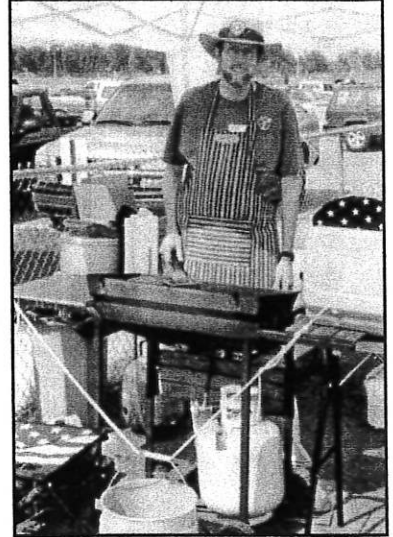


Shirley Park works the registration table and raffle as Mark Lindstrom steps up.
