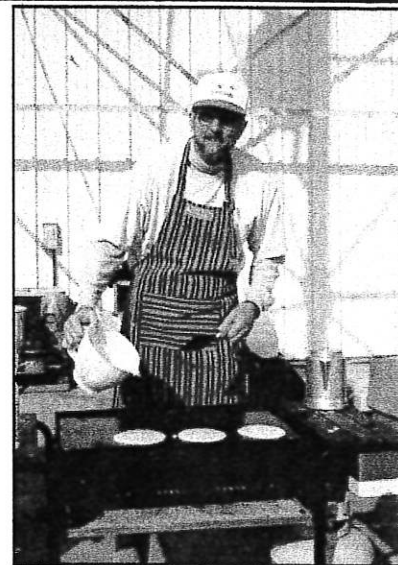

And now a word from our President.

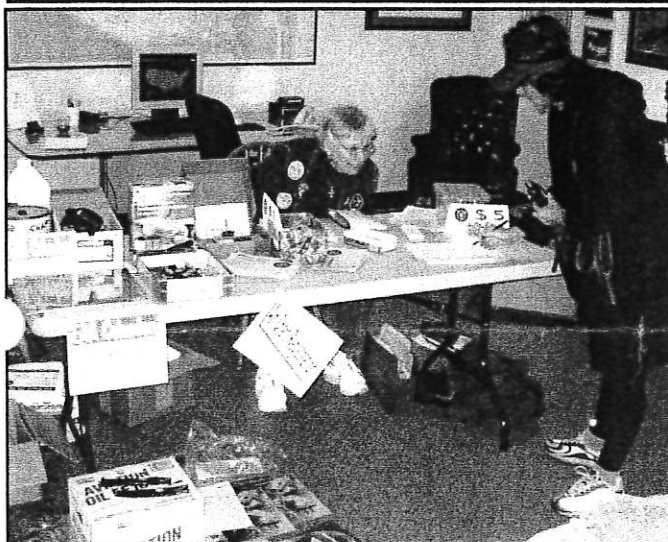
NEW YEAR
